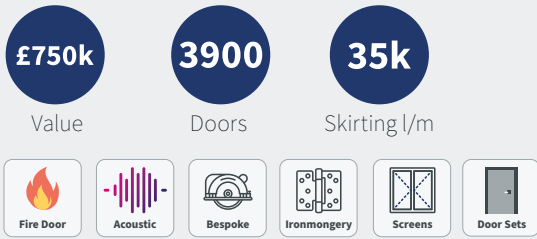




Exchange Square

Acoustic Doors

Soundproofing solutions.

Acoustic doors are manufactured in order to assist in noise reduction. Acoustic doors can be key in maintaining privacy across a number of applications. Birmingham Joinery have manufactured acoustic doors for Hospitals, Theatres, Court rooms, Class rooms, Doctors surgeries and Recording studios.

Our acoustic doors can be manufactured in Veneer, Laminate or Paint grade finish from FD30-FD120.



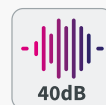
30 Rw dB

Different workspaces have a specific recommended DB rating. Classrooms commonly require 30db. This DB rating will mean that loud speech is clearly audible under normal circumstances. A classroom won't require a high DB due to the fact that there aren't frequent loud sounds coming from the classroom. It will reduce noise coming into the classroom and noise escaping.



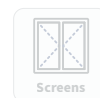
35 Rw dB

A 35DB door set may be found in locations such as a lecture room or a doctor's surgery. This DB rating will mean that loud speech will be audible but difficult to distinguish. This sort of environment will require a higher DB rating than a classroom as greater privacy is required. Lecture rooms are typically bigger and louder than classrooms, a higher DB rating will reduce sound escaping.



40 Rw dB

40DB door sets may be required in an office-based environment. This acoustic rating means that shouting will be audible but cannot be distinguished. A door set with an acoustic rating of 40DB is also popular in cinemas, this ensures that the sounds are unidentifiable from outside the screening room. 40DB door sets are also suitable in court rooms where privacy is key.

Birmingham Joinery is consistently striving towards a cleaner environmental impact and carbon footprint. We are certified by the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®) showing our commitment to sourcing our timber from sustainable sources.

We have invested in recycling facilities and improved packaging to reduce our plastic and cardboard waste. We are transitioning to electric vehicles in our warehouse and energy efficient power tools where possible.



Our Impact

A factory extension was carried out in early 2008 which saw the installation of a state-of-the-art wood burning heating system that heats the factory from the timber waste we produce. The principle benefit of this system is eradication of waste to landfill. Giving us a carbon reduction of over 40 tonnes.

We are committed to reducing our carbon usage and sourcing materials ethically and responsibly, we work closely with our suppliers and partners to ensure they share this vision.

how to.

Care for your door.

All doors will be delivered on pallets using our own transport or one of our trusted courier partners. Our doors are wrapped with bubble wrap and cardboard edge protection to avoid any damage during transportation. Pallets should be unloaded carefully using a forklift and checked for shortages or damages.

For good practice and to avoid invalidating any manufacturers warranty please abide by the following instructions;

- Our doors are heavy and should be handled by at least 2 people to avoid injury.
- Doors must be stored horizontally to avoid bowing.
- Doors should be stored in clean and dry environment.
- Do not deliver doors to site until at least 2 weeks after all wet trades are finished.
- Do not allow doors to be left in direct sunlight as this may fade the veneer or finish.
- Doors subject to alteration, such as planing, must be re sealed to prevent moisture absorption.
- Check with sales team before making any adjustments to the height or width of a door
- Do not remove height from a door on the top edge.
- We recommend a minimum of three hinges per door.

Any shortages or damages must be reported to Birmingham Joinery within 72 hours.
